How does Secularism answer the 4 Big questions?

- Creation: molecules to man evolution; specifically punctuated equilibrium
- Fall: society has an economic problem; the rich/ property owners oppress the workers
- Redemption: The working class must rise up in revolution. Socialism is the answer with private property abolished and class distinctions eliminated
- Eternity: annihilation: there is nothing after physical death

Key definitions of Marxism


- Communism: classless and stateless utopian society in which all private property is commonly owned
- Socialism: the abolition of private property
- Marxism: the philosophy of Karl Marx; and atheistic and materialistic worldview



Key definitions of Marxism


- Dialectic materialism: only the material world exists and class struggles are the mechanism behind social and economic progress
- •Bourgeoisie: the property owners that own the means of production
- Proletariat: working class who don't own the means of production

- Published in 1848
- Subsidized by profits of a private factory
- Marx never worked at physical labor
