The Ten Ideas of Communism

- 1. Abolition of land and application of rents to lands to public purposes
- 2. A heavy progressive or graduated income tax
- 3. Abolition of all rights of inheritance
- 4. Confiscation of all property of immigrants and rebels

The Ten Ideas of Communism

- 5. A national bank with state capital and central capital
- 6. Central communications and transport in the hands of the state
- 7. factories and instruments of production owned by the state
- 8. equal obligation of all work

The Ten Ideas of Communism

- 9. Distribute the population throughout the country
- 10. free education for all children in public schools
