POSTMODERNISM

- It is a worldview that denies all other worldviews
- Truth is not found,
 but constructed



THE 7 ASSUMPTIONS OF POSTMODERNISM

- I. Truth is not found; it is constructed
- 2. Truth does not apply to all people; all we know is our own experience
- 3. We cannot be objective about truth
- 4. There is no neutral knowledge; no worldview can explain everything

THE 7 ASSUMPTIONS OF POSTMODERNISM

- 5. We can't see the world through God's eyes, we must find our own meaning
- 6. We can't have institutions that make objective decisions
- 7. No one can be objective; our experiences color how we see the world

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE OBJECTIVE OR SUBJECTIVE?

- Objective claims are based on unbiased facts, not personal feelings or interpretations
- Subjective claims are based on opinions and feelings as opposed to facts

HOW DOES POSTMODERNISM ANSWER THE 4 BIG QUESTIONS?

- <u>Creation</u>: We can't know how we got here. We are just a collage of social constructs and we are not absolutely anything
- Fall: our problem is adherence to meta-narratives. Each worldview's claim to offer unbiased truth about the world is a problem
- Redemption: We must abandon the search for objective truth; our experiences allow us to generate a theory of living which will allow us to understand our experiences
- Eternity: there is nothing after death; we should forget about eternity

SECULAR WORLDVIEW

• **Secularism**: an atheistic and materialistic worldview that advocates for a society free from religion

HOW DOES SECULARISM ANSWER THE 4 BIG QUESTIONS?

- Creation: We evolved by random chance: molecules to man evolution
- Fall: religion and belief in sinful man have kept society from progressing
- Redemption: No god will save us; we must save ourselves.
 Focus on the "here and now"
- **Eternity**: annihilation: there is nothing after physical death

KEY DEFINITIONS OF MARXISM

- Communism: classless and stateless utopian society in which all private property is commonly owned
- Socialism: the abolition of private property
- Marxism: the philosophy of Karl Marx; and atheistic and materialistic worldview

HOW DOES MARXISM ANSWER THE 4 BIG QUESTIONS?

- Creation: molecules to man evolution; specifically punctuated equilibrium
- Fall: society has an economic problem; the rich/ property owners oppress the workers
- Redemption: The working class must rise up in revolution. Socialism is the answer with private property abolished and class distinctions eliminated
- Eternity: annihilation: there is nothing after physical death
