

- **Eternity**: we go on to our next life to relieve our journey of suffering. This is sometimes called nirvana or stream of consciousness.

KEY DEFINITIONS


- Transcendentalism: human beings are inherently good and nature is fundamentally divine. It is experienced through introspection
- Consciousness: the belief in a divine inter-connected essence of reality





KEY DEFINITIONS

- Reincarnation: a living of life, dying, and being reborn as one becomes more enlightened
- Karma: a law of causality; good is returned to those who do good and evil is returned to those who do evil
- Nirvana: the actual state of the final cessation (end) of suffering
