Redemption: What can we do about it?

- We can't do anything about the brokenness in the world
- We needed a transcendent God to act on the world and fix it

Redemption: How can the world be set right again?

- God is the Redeemer who buys back His wayward creation
- Redeem: to buy back what was once in your possession
- He redeemed us by dying on the cross for our sin and rising to life on the third day (1 Cor. 15:3-4)

What is the gospel?

- We have all sinned and are in need of redemption
- Romans 3:23

- Sin brings eternal separation from God
- Romans 6:23a

What is the gospel?

- God offers eternal life through the gift of Jesus
- Romans 6:23b

- God showed He loved us by dying on the cross
- Romans 5:8

What is the gospel?

- You must confess that Jesus is Lord and believe He rose from the dead

■ *If you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.*
