PHILOSOPHY: 3 KEY QUESTIONS

- What is ultimately real? (Metaphysics)
- What does it mean to know? (Epistemology)
- With what part of our being do we contemplate these questions? (Mind/body problem)

- Metaphysics: Beyond the natural things
- Epistemology: the study of knowledge
- Monists: only one reality exists (body or soul)
- Dualists: there are two natures of reality (body and soul)

NEW SPIRITUALITY

- Metaphysics: only the spirit exists and ultimate reality is consciousness
- Epistemology: truth is known by feeling or experience, not by scientific knowledge
- Epistemology: We need to get in touch with our higher selves

NEW SPIRITUALITY

- Mind/body problem: spirit is the only substance,
 the body is simply a manifestation of the spirit
- The point is not understanding reality but experiencing it

NEW SPIRITUALITY

Example: Pocahontas, "Colors of the Wind"

You think the earth is just a dead thing you can claim, but I know every rock and tree and creature; has a life, has a spirit, has a name.



Atheism
Ultimate reality is matter/ hard science

Truth known by facts; feelings are not important

Pantheism
Ultimate reality
spiritual/
consciousness

Truth is known by feelings/ experience

ISLAM

- Metaphysics: affirms the reality of both the natural and supernatural world
- Epistemology: special revelation through the Quran and fallible human knowledge.
- The Muslim version of special revelation is not open to questioning, dialogue with those who believe differently is difficult

ISLAM

- Mind/body problem: similar to Christianity; mind and body dualism
- The soul is immaterial and immortal but properly resides in the body
